In January 1995 to May 1996 Prime Minister Nguyen Tan Dung was the Deputy Minister for Home Affairs and a Member of the Central Police Party Committee. Between June 1996 and August 2007 he became a Member of the Politburo and Politburo Standing Committee and Director of the CPV Central Committee's Economic Commission, in charge of financial affairs of the CPV. After this time Prime Minister Nguyen Tan Dung became the Deputy Secretary of the Government Party Organization, Governor of the State Bank of Vietnam and Secretary of the State Bank of Vietnam Party Organization. Prime Minister Nguyen Tan Dung left these positions in June 2006 and is now the current Prime Minister of Vietnam.
