Daniel Ringi really belongs to Buini Tusu, a village in the Marovo Lagoon. However when he became a Methodist he moved out of his predominantly SDA village to Patutiva which was the headquarters of the Methodist Church in the area. Well educated for his generation, at various times he served on the local council of the Methodist Church. His wife, Iula, figures in these entries. The Rev. Paul Havea, a Tongan minister, is also referred to. Daniel Ringi was one of the Rev Havea's helpers and advisors. The entries are irregular.
