FIJI MOUNTAIN TRIBE FOUND BULLETS 'VERY HARD TO DIGEST'

An account of a punitive raid by European planters into the mountains of Fiji to avenge the deaths of two of their number is among a collection of century-old letters recently copied on microfilm for the Bureau's member libraries.

The letters were written by James Hall James, an Australian, who was born at Richmond, Victoria, in 1848. He went to Fiji at the height of the cotton boom in 1869 and returned to Australia eight or nine years later after a hurricane had destroyed his crops. He died in 1923 in Melbourne, where his daughter, Mrs L.P. Johnson, still lives. It was Mrs Johnson who kindly made the James letters available to the Bureau for copying.

Writing to his father and mother from a property near Teidamu, on Viti Levu, on 8 October 1871, James said:

Well after a great deal of bother we got 50 whites together & a lot of imported labor & Fijians. We went up inside a Town & killed a few & then retreated - when the wretches commenced to follow us. Then the fun began & I felt what it was to hear a bullet go past & bob carefully. But after a bit I got over that & as I was in the rear guard & the last of them I had plenty of long shots & I think I got a few - but it was raining like fun & all that night when we were camped I [was] stuck up on top of a hill & told to keep a sharp look out when I could not see 5 paces off, it was raining so hard; but we all got safe home & retired, when some more

mountaineers came down two days after & attacked two other whites but the whites shot 3 of them, & we made up our minds for another expedition. 24 whites started. Anthony had just arrived so he came this time. We went alone at 12 o'clock at night & after the d--l's own walk as hard as we could we reached the Town just after day light. We rushed in & shot down all we saw. We then plundered it & burnt everything destroying all else we could. We then sat down & had a smoke with those who had escaped looking at us from the top of a hill a long way off. We then turned home, but had not gone far when we found a feeble attempt made by another Town to ambuscade [us] so we charged & killed five - the rest ran away. We then went home. This last lesson has been a very hard one, but they are all the better for it & they say now that 10 whites can do anything. They are in such a funk. Before that the brutes said - if we were to bring 500 they w^d eat us all, but they now find that bullets are very hard to digest. ...

We have a great deal of work before us now as these beastly interrup[tion]s have made us rather late, but I hope to get a good bit of cotton now. This is the first quiet day I have had now since June last & this is Sunday. I have been on my legs or going about in a boat to try & get these mountaineers cleared out.... But thank goodness we have gained & we are all right again & you need not fear for me as we have now shown the beasts we are able to take care of ourselves & I do not allow any Fijians to come round about me as I find that is the way they kill whites, get round him as friends & then chop him down.... I forgot to tell you I had been very bad with 'saws' all over me. I could not sit down & that was the way I started off for the first expedition but I think it did me good as I began to get all right from that time & am as right as the bank now with the exception of a jaw about twice the proper size w[hich] I am afraid is going to be a big boil....

AND NOW A SECOND BATCH
OF NEW ENGLAND FILMS

Having distributed copies of the first 103 reels of microfilm from the New England Microfilming Project to each of the twelve sponsoring libraries of the project, the PMB is now working on a second batch of 115 reels of film from the same project.

The first 103 reels, numbered PMB 200-302, were micro-filmed by Dr J.S. Cumpston, who was in charge of the project, in the Essex Institute, and Peabody Museum, Salem; the Atheneum Library, Nantucket; and the Old Dartmouth Whaling Museum, New Bedford.

The second batch of films, numbered from PMB 304 onwards, comprises films of whaling logbooks and other documents relating to American activities in Australasian and Pacific waters, which are housed in the Free Public Library, New Bedford and the Nantucket Whaling Museum; and some additional material from the Atheneum Library, Nantucket. These are copies of films purchased from those institutions - microfilming projects having been held there before Dr Cumpston's arrival.

Film PMB 303 (two reels), which bridges the gap between the two sets of films, contains copies of all the information sheets which Dr Cumpston made out before microfilming material in Salem, Nantucket and New Bedford. An information sheet precedes each logbook and other document on films PMB 200-302. These sheets are particularly valuable for reference in that they frequently give exact information about localities visited by the ships listed in the Bureau's four-part provisional index to films PMB 200-302, distributed to the sponsoring libraries with those films. In that index localities visited by the ships are shown only by island group, e.g., Fiji, Society Islands, Tonga, whereas the information sheets frequently give precise place names such as Levuka, Huahine, Nuku'alofa, etc. Therefore, film PMB 303 is likely to be more used by scholars than any other yet distributed in the New England series.

Running lists of the contents of films PMB 303-400 are contained in the next thirty pages. It will be seen from these that the second batch of films includes a great deal of material of value to Australian, New Zealand and Pacific scholars. So far, the Bureau has not been able to compile detailed information about the places visited by each ship in the list, as this involves perusing each individual logbook. However, it is hoped that this can be done before the films are distributed to the sponsoring

libraries about the end of the year.

Pacific scholars are likely to find a particularly high proportion of material of interest to them among the logbooks from the Nantucket Whaling Museum. The Nantucket films include logbooks for a number of very early Pacific voyages. Among these are the voyages of the Aurora (1819-22), Bedford (1797-98), Cyrus (1808-10), Gideon (1821-25), Hannah and Eliza (1804-06), Lady Adams (1802-05), Lydia (1823-27), Ploughboy (1821-24), Rob Roy (1821-24), and the Topaz (1807-08).

The Topaz (Captain Mayhew Folger) was the ship which discovered the hideout of the Bounty mutineers on Pitcairn Island on 6 February 1808. The entry from Captain Folger's logbook for that day is among the minor classics of Pacific literature:

On approaching the shore [he wrote], saw a smoke on the land at which I was very much surprised, it being represented by Capt. Carteret as destitute of inhabitants. On approaching still nearer the land I discovered a boat paddling towards me with three men in her. On approaching her they hailed in the English language asked who was Captain of the ship and offered me a number of cocoanuts which they had brought off as a present, and requested I would land, there being as they said a white man on shore. I went on shore and found there an Englishman by the name of Alexander Smith the only person remaining out of nine that escaped on board the ship Bounty, Capt. Bligh, under the command of that arch mutineer, Christian....

The frames in the films listed on pp. 5-34 are unnumbered. The letter in the first column indicates the order of the documents on the film. Where no letter is shown against the name of a ship, this indicates that no space has been left on the film between the logbook for that ship and the preceding document.
